Biography

Stan Zeff is a World House music pioneer, DJ, producer, radio presenter and founder of Atlanta's legendary Tambor Party. A trailblazer since his early days leading the Shock Sound System at London's Notting Hill Carnival, Zeff has become one of the most respected voices in the deep and soulful house community. After relocating to Atlanta in 2000, he launched Tambor Party in 2009—now regarded as one of the leading Afro, deep and soulful house experiences in the United States.

In recent years, Zeff has expanded the brand with festivals to Egypt and ocean cruises. This year he launched Sol Y Luna, a celebrated series blending music, ritual, and community under the Atlanta sky. The parties have built powerful momentum, drawing dancers into ecstatic experiences that echo Tambor's mission of healing through rhythm.

As a producer, Zeff's releases span King Street, Yoruba, Nervous, Turntables on the Hudson, and his own Tambor Music label, with new projects and collaborations showcasing his evolving sound. His tracks continue to chart globally, balancing spiritual depth with dancefloor energy.

From Burning Man to Chosen Few, Afro Soul Festival to clubs like Djoon, High Museum, and Danté's HiFi, Zeff's reach is worldwide. Playing with DJs Black Coffee, David Morales, Shimza, Louie Vega, his philosophy is simple yet profound: music as ritual—creating safe, inclusive spaces for joy, expression, and transformation.
